

Exam Rules

Failure to adhere to these rules will be considered cheating.

You will be allowed to continue taking the exam; however, you will be reported to the Office of Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution (OSCCR).

On Exam Day

Come 15 minutes early.

Bring your Student ID and/or Government ID.

You will be required to sign-in with the professor at the front of the class. During sign-in

You are checked for electronic devices.

You will remove any hats, hoodies, and/or jackets.

Your bookbag shall be placed against the wall.

You will be assigned a seating row.

Choose a chair and sit separately from your classmates.

Place your student ID, face-up on the desk.

General Rules

<p>1. Sit Separately.</p>	<p>Do not sit directly next to your classmates. Leave a space between each other. If there is no space left. Sit in the front. You are not allowed to communicate with your classmates during the exam.</p>
<p>2. No Bathroom Breaks</p> 	<p>Use the bathroom before class. You may not leave the classroom once the exam has begun. If there is medical reason for bathroom access, contact the Center for Accommodations and Support Services before the exam day.</p>
<p>3. No Book Bags, Water Bottles, etc.</p> 	<p>Place your book bag against the wall of the classroom. There should be no items in your vicinity other than the exam, calculator, pens, and cheat sheet (if permitted).</p>
<p>4. No Electronic Devices</p> 	<p>Cellphones, iPods, Headphones, and other electronic devices should be placed inside your book bag. If you are caught looking at or listening to an electronic devices for any reason you will be reported to OSCCR.</p>
<p>5. No Hats. No Hoodies. No Jackets</p>  <p>NO HATS NO HOODS</p>	<p>Not Hats. No Hoodies. No Jackets. If you have one of these items place them inside your bookbag and place the bookbag on the floor against the wall.</p>
<p>6. Calculators</p>	<p>You may not share calculators.</p>

This list is not exhaustive. There are activities and items that are not permitted that are not listed above. If you have a question about if something is allowed or not communicate this with the instructor before the exam starts.
